#### Day 1

Private transfer Copenhagen airport – 71 Nyhavn Hotel.

On arrival Copenhagen Intl Airport, after pass control and baggage collection, proceed to Arrival Hall where you will be met by your driver with the meeting sign:

as you then head into the historic center of Copenhagen Nyhavn, check in at the hotel 71 Nyhavn Hotel at 14:00

# Day 1

15:00-18:00 3 hrs Copenhagen City tour by car and on foot.

Meet your English-Speaking guide as you then enjoy a sightseeing tour of Copenhagen (photo stops only – no entry) - Christiansborg Palace - Tivoli Gardens - Copenhagen City Hall - Round Tower - Rosenborg Castle - Little Mermaid - Amalienborg Palace - Nyhavn district - Christianshavn district and Christiania. Upon ending of sightseeing tour, be transferred to the hotel.

Must-sees, photo stops: Amalienborg Palace, City Hall, Tivoli park, Christiansborg Palace, Kongens Nytorv, Royal Theater, Harbor of Nyhavn, Little Mermaid statue.



### Day 2

10:00-14:00 4 hrs The Culinary Experience Tour, Incl. guiding service, food tasting, local taxes and fees This morning at 10 am, be met by your English-Speaking guide.

She/he will escort you to the meeting point for 3,5 hrs Culinary Experience Tour, which starts at 10:30. On this walking shared culinary experience tour, distance approx. 3 km / 1,8 miles, you dip into the trendy food and restaurant scene of the Danish capital. With an English-speaking guide, learn about the city's reputation for fresh, national and seasonal cuisine with natural products. Seek out the locals' preferred eateries and markets.

Taste gourmet cheeses, local open sandwiches, organic hot dogs, delicious craft beers and organic gourmet sweet - depending on the season.



## Day 3

10:00-15:00 5 hrs Tour to Viking's city Roskilde from Copenhagen, Incl. tickets to the Cathedral of Kings and the Viking Ship Museum, return transfer, guiding service, local taxes and fees.

This morning at 10 am, be met by your driver and English-Speaking guide.

Embark on a private excursion to Roskilde – nicknamed the city of Kings & Vikings. Visit the Viking Ship Museum (with tickets) and the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Roskilde Cathedral (with tickets). You will probably also have time to wander around the charming old town before we return to Copenhagen.

#### Day 4

10:00-13:00 Palace Visiting 3 hrs (Palace on choice: Rosenborg or Amalienborg), Incl. entrance tickets, guiding service, local taxes and fees. Please, choose 1 from these 2 options.

**Rosenborg Castle** in Copenhagen houses some of Denmark's greatest cultural treasures. The castle was built 1606-34 by Christian IV as a pleasure palace. In the basement you will find the Danish crown jewels and royal crowns. Kings garden Rosenborg is also a great place to walk around if the weather permits.

# Amalienborg or Christian VIII's Palace.

The Amalienborg Palace houses the museum of the Danish Royal Family. The museum explores the history of the Danish monarchy over the past 150 years, and introduces visitors to the daily life of The Royal Family today.



Rest of the day on your own leisure.

10:00-16:00 6 hrs Private Malmö & Dragør tour, Incl. transport in disposal, bridge fee, guiding service, local taxes, and fees.

**Tour description:** tour by car with photo stops and walking.

Transfer Cph- Dragør to visit an old fishing village nearby Copenhagen.

Back in history, Dragør Harbor has been one of the most important maritime cities in Denmark. Both in the latter half of the 18th century and again in the late 1800s, where the vast majority of the houses in the Old Town were also built, which has remained largely unchanged since 1850.

Next, continue our drive to the fascinating city of Malmö in Sweden by The Öresund Bridge, the 2nd longest bridge in Europe. In the Old Town, you will see the magnificent Town Hall, Kockska huset, Apoteket Lejonet and other historic buildings in Stortorget, and stroll through the bustling Lila Torg market square.

Another highlight will be Malmo Castle, which was built by King Christian III of Denmark.

It is the oldest preserved Renaissance castle in the Nordics and a great place to learn about Swedish-Danish history from medieval times to present day.

Included: Photoshop near The Bridge, Free entry to St. Peter's Church, Turning Torso skyscraper and Western Harbor.



## **Day 6** 10-16 6-7 hrs

**Private Louisiana Museum of Modern Art + Hamlet Castle Tour**, Incl. transport in disposal, guiding service, entrance tickets, local taxes, and fees.

Embark on an excursion of North Zealand arriving first at the port city of Helsingor, a bustling city where Danish and Swedish commute for work and leisure. Make a brief stop for coffee admiring the charming cobble streets while also enjoy the opportunity to marvel at the Little Merman statue. Thereafter, we will visit the UNESCO World Heritage-listed **Kronborg Castle** (with tickets).



Later, continue to **Louisiana Museum of Modern Art** (tickets included), which is located in Humlebæk, in a beautiful old park offering magnificent panoramic views of the Sound. The museum buildings lend themselves beautifully to the park, which is landscaped with open lawns, shady woods, a view terrace and a gorge down to the beach. The park provides a magnificent setting for Louisiana's large sculpture collection. Louisiana's collection of modern art dates from 1945 to the present day and contains more than 4,000 artworks within virtually all genres, emphasising painting and sculpture. Permanent highlights include the Giacometti Hall, the Jorn Room and the Kusama Installation.

#### Day 7

10:00-13:00 3 hrs Blue Planet Aquarium Tour, and Canal Cruise, Incl. return transfers, entrance tickets, shared canal cruise and private guiding.

This morning at 10am, be met by your driver and English-Speaking guide.

Today we will visit the Northern Europe's largest aquarium, home to thousands of animals and 7 million litres of water. The National Aquarium of Denmark – Den Blå Planet offers a unique experience, combining entertainment, fascination and knowledge in a spectacular setting. Tickets included.

Highlight of the day and your trip to Denmark is Sightseeing by Boat in Copenhagen. This is the absolute best view of Copenhagen city from it's very best side – the water!
